# CAREER PATHWAYS – STUDENT WORKSHEET



Brea Olinda High School courses are organized to emphasize their interconnections so students can apply their learning to real world applications. The primary goal of career pathways is to equip students with transferable skills necessary for post-secondary education and career employment. Each career pathway is the home of a distinct set of "CORE" courses. Students who successfully complete 60 or more credits in one or more pathways will earn a colored cord distinguishing their pathway(s) to wear at graduation. A minimum of 40 credits must be earned from the career pathway's core courses. The remaining 20 credits may come from additional core courses or from "SUPPLEMENTAL" courses. The credits of any course shall be used only once toward a career pathway cord unless it was repeatable and taken more than once.

Career pathway cords are determined during the second semester from senior transcripts based upon the following: core courses taken from 12th grade backwards; earned credit, not grades; and courses taken in the past but are no longer offered at BOHS or those that are new but not listed shall be considered towards core courses if applicable. CTE Internship credit shall be applied only to the career pathway for which the internship was associated. Courses taken at another schools may be considered towards core courses if applicable; however, honors courses (other than any AP or IB course) shall not be counted unless there is an honors equivalent at BOHS. A student shall earn no more than three career pathway cords. Please Note: After two academic dishonesty violations, the student will lose all academic honors at graduation, NHS, CSF, and Rho Kappa membership. Contact Ms. Cordia.
