



## **Brea Olinda High School Building Industry Technology Academy**

*The Building Industry Technology Academy at Brea Olinda High School is a premier Career Technical Education program and partnership with North Orange County Regional Occupation*

*Program, Home Builder's Council of Southern California, and the Orange County chapter of the Building Industry Association. Rigor, relevance, and relationships result from the fusion of in-depth construction skills training, academic application, and the exposure to diverse careers and industry partners. Students learn transferable skills and plan post-secondary goals.*

*Any current or incoming high school student residing within the BOUSD boundaries can request BITA 1 as an elective course during course selection. There are no pre-requisites. In order to complete the four-course, career pathway program, students take one BITA elective each year, starting in the ninth grade. Students entering BITA in tenth grade must take BITA 3 and BITA 4 concurrently during their twelfth grade year. Students who complete the program may earn a career pathway cord at graduation as well as credit at Fullerton College. ### **STUDENTS FROM OUTSIDE BOUSD:**

Any student who resides in another school district's attendance boundaries and is not already attending a BOUSD school must provide the information listed to the right (A-F) in order to qualify and obtain an acceptance letter. *Please note due to our impacted special education program, we cannot accept students requiring special education services.*

A conditional acceptance letter is necessary for requesting an inter-district transfer release from the student's home district; however, this letter does not guarantee that the student's home district will grant a release. BOHS and BOUSD have no authority to override another district's rejection of the inter-district transfer release request.

All inter-district transfers are expected to maintain satisfactory attendance, discipline, grades, and standardized test scores while enrolled at BOHS. *Please note that BOUSD reserves the right to revoke an inter-district transfer or acceptance letter at any time.*

Currently, the Anaheim Union High School District and the Placentia Yorba Linda Unified School District have similar BITA programs available at one or more of their high schools, thus inter-district transfer releases for the purpose of participating in BITA are likely to be denied.

### **TIMELINE:**

**For Applications Received February-May:** Space will be determined after BOHS course selection is completed in May. Applicants will be notified via email by June 1<sup>st</sup> whether they have been accepted, placed on a wait list, or denied.

**For Applications Received June-August:** Students will be placed on a waiting list and only notified via email if they have been accepted.

### **STEP #1 – APPLICATION INFORMATION**

- A. Completed Application** (found on reverse)
- B. Current Transcript** listing the first semester grades (Please note that poor second semester grades may result in the revocation of the acceptance letter.)
- C. Printout of Attendance History** for the past year or as recorded on a report card
- D. Printout of Student Discipline History** or signed verification on school letterhead that the student has no current or prior suspension/expulsion offenses
- E. Verification** from the current school that the student is not receiving special education services (note: this verification can be combined with the preceding item)
- F. Optional: Copies of Previous standardized testing results** (Please note that strong standardized testing results can enhance a student's candidacy.)

### **STEP #2 – GETTING AN INTER-DISTRICT TRANSFER RELEASE**

Parents will need to take the acceptance letter to their home high school or district office to request an inter-district transfer release. *Please note that the district must release the student before he/she can enroll at BOHS.*

### **STEP #3 – ENROLLING IN BOHS**

Once the student receives an inter-district transfer release, the parent should bring the release plus the additional information outlined on the enrollment checklist found online at [bohs.bousd.us/enrollment](http://bohs.bousd.us/enrollment) to Mrs. Graciarena, Administrative Assistant for Guidance (her contact information is [mgraciarena@bousd.us](mailto:mgraciarena@bousd.us) or 714-990-7850 x1214) before the Guidance Office closes during last week in June. She will process the paper work and schedule a registration appointment in August with one of our counselors or interns.
